Dear Class of 2021 Parents,

We are excited for this year's first field trip! We will be visiting the Watershed Center in Pennington on October 5, 2018. Your children will participate in a real investigation to determine whether or not the stream could support the release of fish into it. They will do abiotic investigations, collect data, and conclude whether or not the fish should be released.

Students should bring a backpack to carry their lunches. Bag lunches will be provided by Chapin, unless you would prefer to send one in with your child. In order to help with our planning, please check the box on the permission slip to let us know NOT to make one for your child if this is the case.

Other items to bring:

- Water bottle no glass
- Extra shoes and socks we will be walking in shallow water.
- Dress for the weather. We strongly encourage all students and chaperones to wear/bring waterproof boots OR hard-soled sandals, such as Keens.
 - Alternatively, students should wear old sneakers that can get wet. Bring dry shoes/socks to change.
 - No one will be allowed to walk barefoot.
- Crocs and flip flops are not appropriate footwear.

Pick up and drop off will be the same as usual. We will depart Chapin for a 10 a.m. arrival at the Watershed Center and return around 2:20 p.m.
